### SECOND HAND BIKE MARKET AT AVONDALE

On Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> February, there will be a Pop-Up Bike Market here at school in the Key Stage 2 playground. 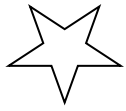
The overall figure for the school for last week was **94.4%**, which was below our target of **96%**.
