News and Reminders

ON-LINE SAFETY

We take on-line safety very seriously at Avondale Park School and St Anne's Nursery and ask all our children and adults to be aware of online safety both when at school and outside of school.

Students and staff are asked to sign a user agreement, which has been written to help keep everyone safe and happy when they are online or using technology.

School systems and users are protected and monitored by security and filtering services to provide safe access to digital technologies. This means that one of the staff members who are here to keep your children safe may view any activity on a school device or school network, platforms, or internet.

We teach our children that they should not behave any differently when they are out of school or using their own device or home network; that is,

"Treat yourself and others with respect at all times; treat people in the same way when you are online or on a device as you would face to face."

The overall figure for the school for last week was **97%, which was above** our target of **96%**

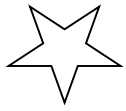
The classes in each Key Stage with the best attendance were:
